alifornia Pizza Kitchen's LA Food Show concept is a celebration of the ever-evolving international culinary world. Aria Group Architects became involved with LA Food Show starting with the Beverly Hills location, which opened in October 2008. Some distinctive features of Aria Group's design include the use of exotic, floating rosewood ceilings, vertical grained zebra wood and rich, Bolivian rosewood walls highlighting a glowing stair. Diners in the mezzanine seating area overlook a dramatic view of the first floor. The design unifies existing architectural components such as exposed wood bow string trusses and aged brick with contemporary elements that reflect Los Angeles' glitz and glamour. The contractor for this location was Shawmut Design & Construction.

Stripburger

FASHION SHOW MALL, LAS VEGAS, NEVADA

This upscale burger bar, an extension of Café Ba Ba Reeba, features specialty burgers and cocktails in a year-round outdoor dining experience on a raised patio accessed by a new stair directly up from the famous Las Vegas "Strip". Diners are seated around the circular bar area consisting of brushed aluminum columns and a bar die wall that is made of backlit channel glass. By night Strip burger comes alive, accented by changing, multi-colored LED lighting. It was built by Focus One Construction.



The building is a one-story, free-standing structure with a variety of dining areas including an energetic bar, private dining rooms and an exterior patio. The focal point of the space is the display kitchen with a wood burning oven. The contractor was Lorient Construction.

The Pinstripes in Northbrook has been such a success for Dale Schwartz that developers around the country are asking him to consider more locations. Nando's Peri-Peri

WASHINGTON, D.C.



In the 1980's, Robert Brozin and Fernando Duarte started Nando's, a UK-based chicken restaurant featuring Peri-Peri chili sauces. Their inspiration came from cuisine created centuries ago by Portuguese settlers in South Africa. When the concept developed a devoted following, Nando's spread worldwide. The opening of the first U.S. location was much anticipated by those who've enjoyed Nando's overseas, and Nando's is now being discovered by the general American public. Casual comfort and natural materials are key elements of the design, but each location reflects local flavor. Nando's walls are a gallery for contemporary African artists, a reflection of the owner's strong support of the arts.

Mon Ami Gabi/ The Canteen

Mon Ami Gabi, a classic French Bistro, is part of a long and fruitful collaboration between Chef Gabino Sotelino and Lettuce Entertain You Enterprises. Aria Group has been involved with the design of several other Mon Ami Gabi locations prior to this one in the Reston Town Center. A new LEYE concept adjacent to the main restaurant, called The Canteen, provides quick meals to-go and wine by the bottle in a modern café-like atmosphere.

Delta Downs Racetrack, Casino and Hotel is a premier Boyd Gaming entertainment venue located two hours from Houston. The Vista Grill offers panoramic views of the racetrack and diners can watch the races in a casual setting. Spaces include private dining, a display kitchen, and tiered seating facing the race course. The bar is scaled for intimacy and has a dramatic liquor display open to the overall pavilion. Warm maple wood is used throughout and Brazilian walnut accents the walls and ceiling.
